- Minister announced 3 possible scenarios for returning to school in the fall
- There will be simplified reporting for TERM 3
- PAT and diplomas remain cancelled
- Last day of online schooling will be June 19
- Fee reimbursement will be decided in June
- Massive budget cuts, Mundare School short \$300,000 from the previous year
- Transportation cutbacks will result in new fee structure Eligible (\$100), ineligible (\$325). There is no family rate
- Grade configurations will be tentative:
  - K/1 18 students
  - 2/3 30 students
  - 4 25 students
  - 5/6 27 students
  - 7/8 28 students
- Drumheller field trip will be discussed in the fall as will all other field trips.
