The screening may help determine your child's eligibility for our preschool program (PALS). Pre-kindergarten programming supports children in reaching emotional, social, intellectual, and physical developmental milestones.


#### JUMP ROPE FOR HEART

#### **ZONES OF REGULATION**

This month we focused on calming regulation strategies, specifically deep breathing. Deep breathing is proven to decrease stress, relieve pain, improve immunity, increase energy among other health benefits. In class, students practiced breathing in like they are smelling a flower and breathing out like they are blowing out a candle. Students reported that they felt calmer and more relaxed after deep breathing. This is an effective strategy in times of frustration, anger, sadness, or even in a content state. Mindful breathing is an effective tool that can be practiced in school, at home, or even in the car!




#### STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

Planning to use Student Transportation in the 2022-23 school year? If so, make sure your child is registered so Elk Island Public Schools (EIPS) can plan routes and send your child a bus pass before the first day of school. All students who indicated needing transportation services through the returning student registration process are now registered. Families registered will received tentative route schedules and invoices by the end of the month—fees are due June 30, 2022.
